Preface

Founded with merely 12 students in the year of 2012, Du Foundation is growing continuously. Today Du Foundation has more than 100 students & about 40 students who are the beneficiaries of different facilities provided by the foundation.

Foundation works in Shahapur area, predominantly having many poor farmers, labourers & Adivasis. Foundation arranges series of lectures, tribal welfare programs, workshops and other social activities for the students from economically deprived society members, provide them opportunities of good education and make them responsible citizen in the society.

Du foundation is registered under Charitable Trust Act & has got 80-G Certificate from Income Tax Department.



Main objectives :

1. To provide financial assistance to needy students to inspire them to become responsible citizen, having high degree of character.
2. To conduct counseling meeting with students and their parents and provide educational career counseling.
3. To solve difficulties which they face while completing education.
4. To imbibe reading culture in the students.
5. To arrange lectures, workshops, training programs to generate awareness about education.

Monthly meeting :

Monthly meeting is held on first Sunday of every month. 12 monthly meetings conducted in the year 2017-18.

On meeting day, students exchange books from library. Students and *Karyakrta Palak* (Guardian) come together for an auspicious prayer in the beginning. Anchoring is done by students during these meetings. Starting with introductions of all the members, previous meeting's report is presented. Students present a review article on the books, which they have recently read. In order to inspire and motivate the students a documentary is shown to them. Documentaries include success stories of well-known individuals. Example, Rajendra Bharan's '*Mi Pahilele Swapna*', Sandeep Maheshwari's documentary on 'Developing communication Skills', IPS officer Mr. Sadanand Date's interview, Mr. Avinash Dharmadhikari's career growth guidance, Padmashri Arvind Gupta's '*Hasat Khelat Ganit*', as well as interviews of Miss. Vishwanjali Gaikwad (IAS) and Pranjal Patil (IAS) who attained high rankings in IAS examination.

One-Day Seminar :

One-day seminar was arranged to create awareness amongst students about various career opportunities available in various commercial fields. In this seminar, Dr. Madhusudan Pendse and Dr. Jakhere guided students on how to prepare for competitive examinations like UPSC and MPSC. Dr. Vaidehi Daphtardar provided guidance on career opportunities in commerce field. Mr. Bharmal provided and guided on the available career opportunities in forest department. 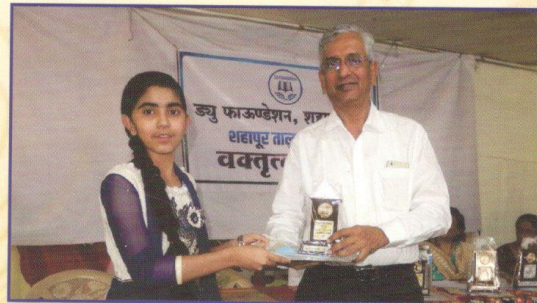
